NHM invites applications from eligible candidates for filling up the following positions on contractual basis in Sub centres of the State. Candidate is requested to apply to District Health Officer, Zilla Parishad of the districts he /she wish to work.

❖ **Terms & Conditions for appointment:**

1. Selected candidates will be initially sent for six months training at any Hospital in the state.
2. Candidates will be paid a stipend of Rs 10,000/- per month during the training period.
3. After completion of six months training candidate will have to appear for exit exam. Candidate successfully completing the exit exam will only be appointed as Community Health Officer at sub centres in the same or nearby district as per vacancy & requirement of program.
4. Candidate is expected to examine out-patients, do at least ten home visits daily and provide comprehensive primary health care services to community in Sub-Centre areas.
5. Candidate successfully clearing the exit exam will get a certificate which will be applicable only for working as a Community Health Officer at sub centre. This certificate does not make the candidate eligible for any specialisation/private practice.
6. Candidate not clearing exam in two attempts will not be eligible for appointment as Community Health Officer.
7. There is no separate provision for accommodation and other allowances during training period.

❖ **General Terms and Conditions:**

1. These posts are purely contractual and not state government's regular posts.
2. Number of posts and reservation may change.
3. Criteria for selection will be the BAMS or BUMS final year marks of candidates.
4. Candidates holding higher qualification will be eligible for maximum of 5% additional marks (PG Diploma - 2% & PG degree- 5%).
5. Candidates having experience of working with Government/National Health Mission /Semi-government organizations are eligible for 1% additional marks per year, maximum up to 5 % marks.
6. Candidates willing to work in Taluka of his/her residence will be given 20% additional marks and candidates willing to work in district of his/her residence will be given 10% additional marks (Maximum 20% Marks).
7. Vertical and Horizontal reservation will be applicable for appointment to Community Health Officer post.
8. Only shortlisted candidates will be eligible for training.
9. The candidates clearing exit exam will be appointed initially for 11 months, likely to be extended subject to continuation of the project from Gol. If the same is not extended; candidate cannot claim any right on the post or permanency of job or Job protection by Government or Any litigation regarding the employment protection.
10. Age criteria for open category will be 38 years and for reserved categories it will be 43 years.
11. Age criteria will be relaxed by 5 years for existing National Health Mission employees.
12. The selection committee reserves all the rights to modify or change all the above mentioned criteria without any prior intimation.
13. Application Form should be submitted in prescribed format only along with photograph and one set of self-attested photo copies of all documents to the District Health Officer of concerned District, where the candidate wishes to apply. Application fee for reserved category is Rs.200 & for Open category will be Rs. 300. Application fee should be submitted via Demand Draft in the name of **District Integrated Health & Family Welfare Society Name of District...where to apply** Applications can be submitted by Register post/Speed Post/By Hand.
14. Last date of receipt of Application form is 28/02/ 2019. Application Form received after last date will not be considered.
15. Candidates are advised to keep their e-mail ID active. All future correspondence shall be sent via e-mail or respective districts website.
